



## Outdoor Classroom Volunteer

### Overview:

Outdoor Classroom Volunteers support Parklands interpretive staff in delivering hands-on educational programming during field trips, camps, and other programs.

### Tasks:

- Assist with set-up and/or breakdown of classroom
- Help supervise students and campers in both a classroom and outdoor setting

### Skills and Requirements:

Outdoor Classroom Volunteers work alongside staff to deliver fun, discovery-based programming to children, so a desire to work with kids is a must. Volunteers must be comfortable working in an outdoor setting including assisting with hikes, creek programs, and more. Weekday availability is required. All Outdoor Classroom Volunteers must undergo a full background check and sign a waiver release form.

### Time Commitment:

Outdoor Classroom volunteer opportunities take place during the weekday and are typically broken into 4-hour shifts. This position allows for flexibility with scheduling.

### Support and Training:

Outdoor Classroom Volunteers will go through a training and orientation with Parklands staff. This training covers visitor and volunteer safety and provides an overview of The Parklands of Floyds Fork, as well as an overview of what to expect during a typical volunteer shift. Outdoor Classroom Volunteers work directly with park staff throughout the volunteer shift. Ongoing training and enrichment programs are available.

### Benefits:

Outdoor Classroom Volunteers receive invitations to appreciation events as well as special programs and outings offered only to Parklands volunteers. Additional benefits include a fun and relaxed training, a chance to work outdoors and meet new people, and the opportunity to make a positive impact as a valued part of the Parklands volunteer team.
