

# FINs MISSION

Fishing in Neighborhoods (FINs) is a program that was created to bring fishing opportunities near cities of all sizes throughout the state of Kentucky. Each lake within the program receives a regular stocking of channel catfish and rainbow trout. The lakes will be regularly sampled and anglers' needs assessed to ensure lakes are meeting the needs of anglers. Stocking of hybrid sunfish and/or largemouth bass will occur if needed.

## SEASONAL REGULATION

To preserve the diversity of fish found in Floyds Fork, trout are under a seasonal catch and release regulation from Oct. 1 through Mar. 31. All trout caught in Floyds Fork Creek during this period of time must be immediately released.
